ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated 24.05.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 11.07.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 10.10.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Matter was fixed for today i.e. 07.02.2023.
- 2. In today's hearing, representative of the appellant states that information has been supplied to him except for one vehicle number i.e. PAT 2165 which is mentioned in his RTI application at Sr. No. 1 and further requests to direct the respondent PIO to supply the same.
- 3. Shri Parmod Kumar, Data Entry Operator states that the record of this vehicle number i.e. PAT 2165 is not available in their official record and further adds that it is more than 20 years old and most of the old record was destroyed in flood in the year 1993.
- 4. After discussing with both the parties, I am of the view that the PIO concerned is directed to supply an affidavit in original in connection with vehicle no. PAT 2165 as per RTI application mentioning the reason that why the information (in relating to vehicle number PAT 2165) could not be supplied to the appellant within ten days after receipt of this order with a copy to the Commission.
- 5. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is disposed off and closed. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
