Order

The RTI Application is dated 12.07.2022 vide which the appellant has sought the information regarding the inquiry on his complaint dated 05.04.2022 as enumerated in his RTI Application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 17.9.2022 and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on 18.10.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today.

2. The appellant states that he no information has been provided to him pertaining to his complaint dated 5.4.2022 addressed to the Education Minister, Punjab.

3. The PIO states that information has been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 1313 no.20.1.2023. She further states that no action is required to be taken on the complaint of the appellant. She further states that the appellant had filed Appeal case no. 2887/2018 in the Commission which was disposed on 17.10.2019 wherein he has sought the action taken on his complaint filed in Complaint Cell o/o DPI, Mohali on the similar subject as in the present case. The PIO has sent a letter to the Commission which is taken on record and the same is being **sent** to the appellant along with the order.

4. It has been noticed that the appellant has filed RTI application with PIO o/o Education Minister, Punjab. The RTI application was transferred to DPI(SE), Punjab and again transferred to PIO o/o DEO(EE), Fatehgarh Sahib.

4. After hearing the parties and going through the reply of the PIO, the Commission accepts the reply of the PIO. Since the appellant has been provided the status of his complaint, no more cause of action is required in this case. Hence this case is disposed of and closed.
