Present: ORDER

1. The RTI application is dated 11.04.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 16.05.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 19.10.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Suresh Kumar Sharma, appellant states that no information has been supplied to him.

3. Neither the PIO has come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench nor through cisco webex nor he has deputed any of his representatives to attend the hearing on behalf of the PIO.

4. Commission takes a serious view of the casual approach of the Respondent / PIO, as no information stands supplied and nobody appears from the department to represent this case in today's hearing.

5. In view of the foregoing, respondent <u>PIO, O/o MC, Amritsar is directed to Show Cause in</u> <u>writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act,</u> as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for wilful delay/ denial of the information to the RTI applicant and why the compensation be not awarded to the appellant under Section 19 (8)(b) of the Act for detriment suffered.

In addition to his submission, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) proviso, thereto, for a personal hearing before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. He may note that in case he does not file his submission and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte. A copy of RTI application be sent to the PIO along with this order through registered post.

7. A copy of this order be also sent to the First Appellate Authority i.e. Commissioner, MC, Amritsar through registered post for the compliance of this order and to look into the matter as RTI Act, 2005 came into existence to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority, not for the harassment of the public.
