ORDER (Fourth Hearing):

- 1. This order may be read with the reference of previous order of the Commission dated 30.11.2022 (Due to some reason all the cases of hearing date 13.03.2023 were adjourned to 15.03.2023.)
- 2. At the time of hearing of this case, the appellant was not present only the- then PIO of BDPO Majri Ms. Nidhi Sinha (who is presently posted as DDPO Fatehgarh Sahib) represented the case. Ms. Sinha pleaded that the sought information has already been supplied to the appellant. In addition to this she tendered his unconditional apology for this lapse and requested the Commission to condone the same the penalty proceedings (order dated 30.11.2022 amount Rs. 10,000/-) against her in the matter.
- 3. Keeping in view the facts of the case and after going through the case file, the penalty proceedings (order dated <u>30.11.2022</u> amount Rs. 10,000/-) under the provision of Section 20(1) stands dropped.

The Respondent is however, cautioned to exercise due care in future to ensure that correct and complete information is furnished timely to the RTI applicant(s) as per provisions of the Act failing which penal proceedings under <u>Section 20</u> shall be initiated.
