**ORDER**

1. This case may be read with reference to the previous order dated 09.02.2023 passed by the Bench during the previous hearing.
2. Shri Jaspreet Singh, Wrestling Coach comes present in person before the Bench for today's hearing and states that information has been supplied to the appellant on his email ID as well as also sent by registered post vide letters dated 06.12.2022 and 06.02.2023.
3. Shri Gulshan Kumar, appellant also comes present in person and states that respondent is talking about another RTI application and no satisfactory response has been given to him regarding the RTI application under hearing.
4. Both the parties are sent to the adjacent court room to go through and discuss the information sought and documents brought by the Respondent. Both the parties are called again in the Court room before the Bench after their discussion. The appellant shows his dissatisfaction over the reply given by the respondent.
5. The Bench, on perusal of documents on file and hearing the version of the respondent is convinced that inputs provided relate to AC 5054/2022 only and observes that the information as available in the official records stand supplied to the appellant. Now, the Bench directs the PIO O/o District Sports Office, Ludhiana to file an affidavit on e-stamp paper, within 21 (Twenty one) days, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in the official records in AC No.5054/2022 has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that the information supplied is true and correct and nothing has been concealed therein. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and copy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.
6. With the aforesaid directions, the instant appeal case is hereby, **disposed off and closed**. Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
