ORDER:

1. This case may be read with the reference to the previous order dated 11.01.2023.
2. Shri Navdeep Sharma, Vigilance Officer states that they have brought the record before the Bench to be inspected by the appellant and the Bench.
3. Both the parties are sent to the adjacent court room to go through and discuss the information sought and documents brought by the respondent. Both the parties are called again in the Court room before the bench after their discussion.
4. Shri Gagandeep Singh, appellant states that incomplete information has been supplied to him . He further mentions that he has identified important letters from the file which he requires and the same has been informed to Shri Rajeev Sagggar, Superintendent during the inspection. He also requests for information in relation to point number 2 & 3 as mentioned in the previous orders of the Bench dated 11.01.2023.
5. Shri Rajeev Sagggar, Superintendent states that finalized and closed report has been received from the office of Improvement Trust, Ludhiana in relation to point number 1, 4, 5, 6 and 7 whereas the enquiry in relation to point number 2 and 3 is still in process. The same cannot be disclosed as it will effect on the outcome of the enquiry.
6. Post deliberations, the Bench directs the PIO O/o Chief Vigilance Officer, Local Govt. Punjab , Chandigarh to supply the attested copies of concerned correspondence as requested by the appellant during the inspection of files and further PIO is directed to file an affidavit on e-stamp paper, within 21 (Twenty one) days, duly signed by the notified PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information sought by the appellant in the RTI application of Appeal Case no: 5088 /2022 has been provided as exiting in official records. It is further clarified that information relating to point number 2 and 3 has been with held as enquiry is under process. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. The original affidavit be sent to the appellant and copy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.
7. With the aforesaid directions, **the instant appeal case is disposed off and closed**. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
