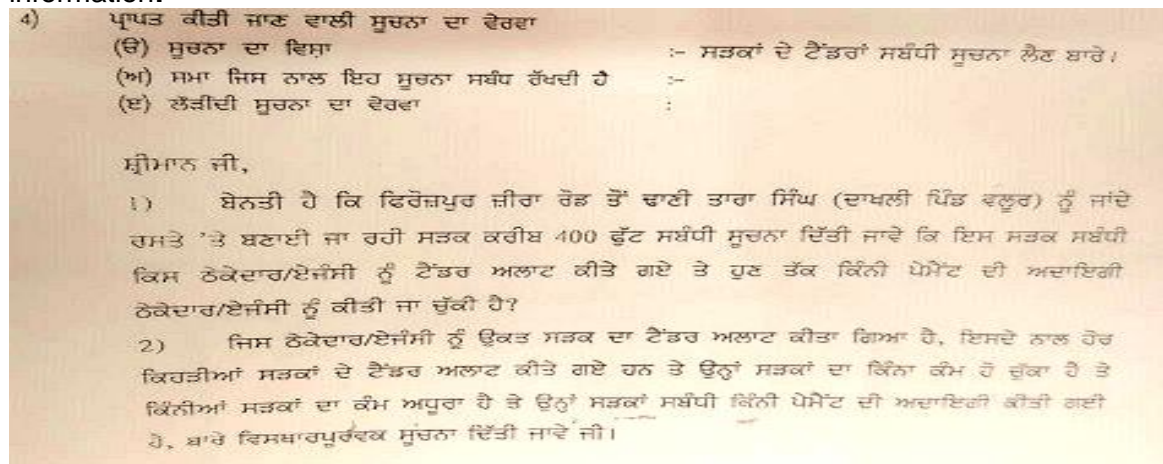
### Complaint Case No. 520 of 2022 (Video Conference Proceedings)
