ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 16.11.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 15.12.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 10.01.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. The case has been heard today. As per respondent, the information has been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 15.12.2022 and a copy of the same has been sent to the Commission.
3. The appellant is absent. The appellant was contacted on his mobile. He states that the PIO has provided copy of the notings however no documents have been provided relating to the basis on which action has been taken against the appellant by the department.
4. As per respondent, there is no such rule and hence no information exists in the official records.
5. Having gone through the RTI application and after hearing both the parties, the PIO is now directed to file an affidavit mentioning therein that the information as available in the official record relating to the RTI application dated 16.11.2022 has been provided to the appellant and no further information is available in the record. The statement made is true and correct and nothing has been concealed therein. The affidavit should be on e-stamp paper duly signed by the PIO and attested by Notary Public. The affidavit in original be provided to the appellant within 21 days of the receipt of the order and a copy of same be sent to the Commission for record.
5. With the above order, the case is **disposed of and closed**. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
