#### ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 21.10.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information:-

Respected Sir Is there any Legislation or Rule Regulations set for Yoga Teachers, Yoga Players, Yoga Therapists and Other yoga Professionals? As there are number of yoga practitioners are in Punjab. Many universities and colleges providing yoga degree courses. Whi is the planing about their future? How department differentiate the Qualified and Un-Qualified yoga professionals as there are non qualified yoga practitioners teaching yoga to public in every street? Who is responsible for any miss happening to them those are getting yoga classes from unprofessional or unqualified so called yoga gurus? What is the future of Yoga players those are participating in Punjab Scho Education Board Games under yoga game? Are they eligible for scholarship and is there any gradation of their certificates? Is there any pla for recruitment of yoga teachers and yoga coaches in different departments of Punjab? Who is teaching yoga to players those are participating yoga games in schools in the absence of Qualified Yoga Teachers?

as enumerated in his RTI application. First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **2.11.2022** and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **9.11.2022** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Notice was issued to the parties for first hearing in the Commission on **13.1.2023**.

2. The appellant is absent without intimation. The respondent PIO, represented by Sh. Lalit Goyal, APIO-cum-Deputy Director, has submitted a reply to this Commission's Notice of Hearing vide Letter No. SPL-1 Dated 2.1.2023, wherein the RTI application has been reproduced in full. The Commission has examined the same and finds that the request for information does not qualify "as information defined by Section 2(f) of the RTI Act, 2005". Furthermore, the Public Authority to which the RTI application was made i.e. Punjab State Planning Board, has already stated that the requested information does not relate to the Planning Department.
