ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated 08.08.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 08.09.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 15.11.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 23.01.2023. Accordingly, the case has been heard today. Shri Jasbir Singh, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing in person or through cisco webex.
- 3. Shri Jagpal Singh, SDO and Sh.Kanwaljeet Singh, S.D.C., Sub Division City, PSPCL, Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib come present in person before the Bench. Shri Jagpal Singh, SDO produces before the Bench authority letter to represent the appeal case as also copy of information. He states that the information has been supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 27.09.2022 and again vide letter dated 22.11.2022. He further states that the appellant was called by First Appellate Authority on 17.01.2023 at Ludhiana, but the appellant did not turn up for the hearing.
- 4. Since the appellant is absent, attempts are made to contact him on his mobile phone. In spite of various attempts made, he does not respond to the phone calls. On the asking of the Bench, the respondent states that the information as available in the official records has been supplied to the appellant.
