**ORDER:**

1. The RTI application is dated 01.08.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 06.09.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 22.11.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 16.01.2023. Accordingly, the case has been heard today. Shri Manjit Singh, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing either in person or through cisco webex.
3. Shri Vipan Kumar, AEE and Shri Gian Singh, UDC, Urban Sub Division, PSPCL, Jalalabad (W), District Fazilka come present in person before the Bench to attend the hearing on behalf of the PIO. The respondent states that point wise information has been supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 12.09.2022 by hand which has been duly acknowledged by the appellant on the letter itself.
4. Since the appellant is absent, he is contacted on his mobile phone. He is apprised of the version of the respondent and is also made to talk to the respondent. The respondent Shri Gian Singh explains to him the information supplied.
5. On the asking of the Bench, the appellant confirms the receipt of information to his satisfaction and also gives his consent to close the case.
6. In view of the above, no further cause of action is left in the matter. **As such, the instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
