ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 01.03.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 23.05.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 13.12.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 20.02.2023. Accordingly, the case has been heard today. Shri Suhas Aggarwal, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench or through cisco webex. He has, however, sent an e.mail dated 14.02.2023 wherein he has made written submissions but has not clarified as to whether he will attend the hearing or not.

3. Shri Satish Kumar, DSP, Nangal and ASI Sardul Singh O/o SSP Roopnagar, come present in person before the Bench to attend the hearing on behalf of PIO/Respondent. ASI Sardul Singh states that repeated phone calls were made to the appellant on his mobile phone No.98689-55495 but he did not respond and as such, information on four points asked for by him has been sent by ordinary post on 26.04.2022. Shri Satish Kumar, DSP states that with regard to matrimonial dispute, a compromise had been reached between the appellant and his wife and both have separated with mutual consent after exchange of articles/money already given to each other.

4. Since the appellant is absent, he is contacted on his mobile phone. In spite of repeated attempts made to contact, he does not respond.

5. After hearing the version of the respondents and perusing the affidavit filed with regard to compromise reached between the appellant and the submissions of appellant, the Bench is convinced that adequate information stands supplied to the appellant.
