## ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated 05.09.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 14.11.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 17.01.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The case has been heard today. As per appellant, the PIO has not supplied the information.
- 3. As per respondent, the available information has been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 29.09.2022. The respondent also submits a copy of reply in the Commission which is taken on record. It has been mentioned in the reply that the appellant has asked for action taken report on sale warrants dated 23.05.2022, 16.06.2022 & 02.08.2022 issued by Hon'ble Court of Sh.Bhupinder Singh, JMIC Patiala. Since the action was to be taken by Tehsildar Patiala, the Tehsildar Patiala was asked vide letters dated 31.05.2022, 07.07.2022 & 22.08.2022 to take necessary action as per order of the Hon'ble Court and send report but the Tehsildar Patiala has not yet taken any action on the court order. The reply to this effect has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 29.09.2022 alongwith copies of letters issued to the concerned Tehsildar.
- 4. Having gone through the RTI application and hearing both the parties, the PIO is now directed to file an affidavit mentioning therein that the Tehsildar Patiala was asked vide letters dated 31.05.2022, 07.07.2022 & 22.08.2022 to take necessary action as per order of the Hon'ble Court of JMIC Patiala, however Tehsildar Patiala has not yet taken any action on the court order. The statement made is true and correct and nothing has been concealed therein. The affidavit should be on e-stamp paper duly singed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public. The affidavit in original be sent to the appellant within 21 days with a copy to the Commission.
- With the above order, the case is disposed off and closed. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
