**ORDER**

1. The RTI application is dated 25.05.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 27.06.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 31.08.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). The above mentioned case i.e. AC: 4000 /2022 was fixed for 06.09.2022 but was postponed and was then fixed for today's hearing.

2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Sunil Sharma, GI states that the information has been sent to the Appellant, Shri Gurmej Lal and a copy of same i.e. letter number 786 dated 27.07.2022 comprising of 60 pages is also handed over to the bench during the hearing, which is taken on record. He also submits proof of sending the information to the Appellant by submitting a copy of their office dispatch register.

3. Shri Gurmej Lal, appellant is absent without any intimation to the Commission. He has neither come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench nor through cisco webex nor he has deputed any representative to attend the today's hearing on his behalf.

4. Shri Gurmej Lal, appellant can also collect a copy of information from the undersigned bench if he fails to receive the information by post which has been sent to him by the department.

5. Post deliberations, the Bench finds that point wise information has been supplied to the appellant, Shri Gurmej Lal and the undersigned bench is satisfied with reply sent to the Appellant.

6. So, no further cause for intervention is left in this case. **This case is disposed of and closed.**
