ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated 24.09.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in her RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 26.10.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 17.01.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

- 4. The appellant states that she has received the reply but is not satisfied with the same. She adds that she has asked for a copy of the policy on the basis of which benefits are given to the nominee of deceased person in PSPCL.
- 5. The respondent clarifies that he has provided copy of the policy on the same of the year 2012. He further adds that there have been no changes in this policy since then.
- 6. The Bench peruses the reply of the respondent and finds that the RTI application of the appellant has been correctly replied to.
- 7. Since, the information as sought by the appellant has been provided, no further cause of action is left in the instant Appeal case. The case is **disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
