ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 05.08.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 06.10.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 30.01.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. The case has been heard today. The appellant is absent and vide letter received in the Commission on 01.03.2023 has sought exemption due to ill health. The appellant has further mentioned in the letter that the information provided is incomplete since the PIO has not specified/provided the detail of distribution of work of concerned inspectors as sought in the RTI application.
3. As per respondent, the information as available in official records has been provided vide letter dated 20.10.2022 and 12.12.2022 and no further information is available relating to this RTI application. In reference to the observation of appellant, the respondent states that work distribution/allotment is mentioned in the ongoing para of office order dated 06.10.2022 sent to the appellant along with letter dated 20.10.2022. The Commission has also received reply of the PIO dated 05.04.2023 through email which is taken on record.
4. Having gone through the RTI application and reply of the APIO, the Bench finds that the RTI application has been sufficiently replied to and no further interference of the Commission is needed. A copy of reply received from the PIO be sent to the appellant along with the order.
5. The case is **disposed off and closed**. Copies of order be sent to concerned parties.
