- As the complainant has not exhausted the channel of approaching First Appellate Authority under Section 19 of the RTI Act, hence, the instant complaint case is remanded to First Appellate Authority, who is Addl. Deputy Commissioner(Urban), Sangrur, with the directions to decide the case as per provisions of the RTI Act, after giving due opportunity to the parties concerned, examining the evidences, documents placed on record/submitted by the parties concerned and subsequently pass a speaking order within forty five days from the receipt of this order.
