## <u>ORDER</u>

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 21.11.2022, passed by the Commission, vide which the respondent was not present.

2. Today the complainant states that no information has been given to him so far and the respondent was again absent today.

3. The perusal of the file shows that the complainant filed RTI with the PIO, o/o EO, MC, Zirakpur on 25.04.2022, but after lapse of seven months, no information has been given to him so far. This shows that he respondent has no regard for the orders issued by the Commission. This is indeed a serious matter.

4. In view of the above, *PIO- o/o MC, Zirakpur is directed* to show cause in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for willful delay/ denial of the information to the RTI applicant and why the compensation be not awarded to the complainant under Section 19 (8)(b) of the Act for detriment suffered.

In addition to his submission, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) proviso, thereto, for a personal hearing before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing.
