(31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the High Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information).

As such, since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provision of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

5. In the complaint cases, it is to be seen whether the intention of the respondent-PIO is clear or not. The respondent-PIO has given reply to the RTI application. Hence, the complaint case filed in the Commission is **disposed of and closed**. Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
