#### ORDER

## Appeal Case No. 5668 of 2021

It is, thus apparent from the response of the PIO O/o Respondent no. 2 that there has been delay in providing the information. Appellant had also suffered financial loss in getting the information. There are systemic deficiencies in the manner of receiving and disposing of applications. The department still does not appear to be properly tuned to the performance of its obligations enshrined under the RTI Act. The departmental officials are not properly sensitized and trained to discharge their functions under the RTI Act 2005.

- 5. I am, therefore, of the view that the Appellant deserves to be awarded compensation under Section 19(8)(b) of RTI Act 2005 for the loss and detriment suffered by him on account of delayed supply of information.
- 6. I am of the view that ends of justice would be met by awarding a sum of Rs. **5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only)** by way of compensation to the Appellant. This amount shall be payable by State Exchequer within fifteen days.
- 7. Respondent may take note that this is the last opportunity given to appear before the Commission, otherwise bailable warrant will be issued.
- 8. To come up on **12.12.2022 at 12.00 PM** for further proceedings in the Commission. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
