2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 01.02.2021 through CISCO Webex.


3. The respondent states that the information has already been sent to the appellant.

<u>ORDER</u>

1. The RTI application is dated 06.07.2020vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 03.11.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 01.02.2021 through CISCO-Webex (Video-Conferencing Application)

3. The Appellant - Sh. Harbinder Singh states that no information has been provided to him so far.

4. The Respondent -Sh. Manjeet Singh, Assistant Registrar states that the information sought by the Appellant is very voluminous and not specific. Hence, it cannot be provided. The Respondent has also filed their reply in this regard which is taken on record.

4. After hearing both the parties and perusing the documents placed on record, it is ascertained that the information demanded by the Appellant is very voluminous. The appellant may take note that there is the judgment of The Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 6454 of 2011 Central Board of Secondary Education **Vs** Aditya Bandopadhyay and ors. dated 09.08.2011 clears that

(37 Indiscriminate and impractical demands or directions under RTI Act for disclosure of all and sundry information (unrelated to transparency and accountability in the functioning of public authorities and eradication of corruption) would be counter-productive as it will adversely affect the efficiency of the administration and result in the executive getting bogged down with the non-productive work of collecting and furnishing information. The Act should not be allowed to be misused or abused, to become a tool to obstruct the national development and integration, or to destroy the peace, tranquility and harmony among its citizens. Nor should it be converted into a tool of oppression or intimidation of honest officials striving to do their duty. The nation does not want a scenario where 75% of the staff of public authorities spends 75% of their time in collecting and furnishing information to applicants instead of discharging their regular duties. The threat of penalties under the RTI Act and the pressure of the authorities under the RTI Act should not lead to employees of a public authorities prioritising 'information furnishing', at the cost of their normal and regular duties.)

5. In view of the above, the Appellant is directed to file a fresh RTI seeking specific information if he so desires. In view of aforementioned, the appeal Case is **closed and disposed of.** Copy of the orders be sent to the parties.
