ORDER

1. 3. The Commission after considering the submission of the respondent authority transpires that respondent PIO of PWD B&R, Ludhiana is exempted in this case.

Moreover, Viewing the absence and non-implementation of the order of the commission O/o **MC, Ludhiana**, seriously, the PIO is thus issued a **show cause** notice under Section 20 of the RTI Act 2005 and directed to file reply on an affidavit. On other hand, the appellant is hereby, directed to revert back to the authorities in case of deficiencies, if any, in the information so supplied by the respondent before the next date of hearing.

1.
