1. The RTI application is dated 17.02.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 23.07.2020 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 11.09.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 01.12.2020 by the Commission through Video Conferencing facility in the office of D.C. Ludhiana. Shri Gulshan Kumar, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing. However, a telephonic message has been received from the son of appellant Shri Gulshan Kumar that his father is admitted in a hospital for undergoing an operation due to which he cannot attend the hearing.
3. Shri Harjit Singh, Draftsman, representative of the PIO, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana comes present to attend the hearing through V.C. and states that the information has been sent to the appellant vide letters dated 22.07.2020 and 04.09.2020.

He further states that in the First Appeal, the appellant had appeared before the First Appellate Authority on 08.09.2020 in First Appeal No.239 of 2020 wherein the appellant had expressed his satisfaction over the information supplied. He also states that acknowledgement for receipt of information given by the appellant has been enclosed with the letter dated 11.11.2020 sent to the Commission.

4. On perusal of the case file, the Bench observes that the information stands supplied to the appellant and the appellant had also acknowledged the receipt of information to his satisfaction, in the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority.

5. In view of the above, no further intervention of the Bench is called for. **The appeal is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
