The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The appellant is absent today, whereas the respondent is present and he stated that letter dated 25.10.2021 was written to the appellant for depositing the requisite fee for getting the information, but till date he has not deposited the same.

The appellant has filed RTI application on 05.06.2021, but the respondent has demanded the requisite fee vide letter dated 25.10.2021, which is not demanded within the stipulated period.

So the PIO is directed that the attested copies of sought for information, specifically point-wise, be sent to the appellant free of cost through registered post within 2 days and copy of the same be sent to the Commission for compliance. In case of non compliance of the order of the Commission strict action will be taken against the PIO under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

O R D E R

Shri Ravi Kumar, appellant filed RTI application dated 14.07.2021 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Tehsildar, Nakodar, Distt. Jalandhar. When no information was provided to him by the SPIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 18.08.2021 and then Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 11.10.2021. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The appellant is personally present today, whereas none has come present on behalf of the SPIO. The appellant stated that the sought for information has not been provided to him by the SPIO.

The SPIO though is absent, but he has sent a mail to the Commission on 24.11.2021, diarized vide no.26420, which is a copy of letter no.491 dated 15.11.2021 along with copy of letter no.239 date 17.09.2021, copy of letter no 87 dated 16.07.2021 and copy of postal receipt dated 16.11.2021.

I have gone through letter no.491 date 15.11.2021 vide which the reply was sent to the appellant and it is replied by the SPIO that the applicant can get the attested copy of Vasika (sale deed) from the Seva Kendra by depositing the requisite fee.

Though there is procedure that the copy of any deed can be obtained by filing the application in the Sewa Kendra, but so far as the procedure under the Right to Information Act, 2005 is concerned the appellant can avail this opportunity also. As the appellant invoked the jurisdiction under the RTI Act, 2005, so, he is entitled to get the certified copy of the said deed.

So, the SPIO is directed that in case any deed is registered regarding the Gaushala Trust, then the certified copy of that deed be provided to the appellant within a week and compliance be sent to the Commission. In case of non compliance of the order of the Commission, action will be taken against the SPIO under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.
