Neither the respondent PIO nor any of his representative is present in today's hearing. He has also not sent any intimation regarding his non-availability. The Commission took a serious view of this casual approach of the respondent PIO.

In view of the above, <u>a show cause notice under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act is</u> <u>issued to Public Information Officer concerned of office of Principal Secretary to Government of</u> <u>Punjab, Deptt. of Local Government, Chandigarh, as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for</u> <u>willful delay/denial in supplying the information to the RTI applicant under the provisions of the</u> <u>RTI Act, 2005.</u>
