ORDER:

The appellant through an RTI application dated 01.10.2020 has sought information regarding a copy of the first-time license for de-addiction centres issued and renewed – name and appointment letters of various persona under whom these centres are running along with the degrees of doctors and registration with MCI/PMC – letter/enquiry/prosecution against the centres -name of minister/his OSD at the time of license issued and renewed -the name of the drug inspector and other information as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of Director, Health and Family Welfare Pb Chandigarh. The appellant was asked to vide letter dated 26.10.2020 deposit a fee of Rs.480/- which the appellant deposited on 06.11.2020 but the information was not provided, after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the first appellate authority on 26.02.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case last come up for hearing on 13.10.2021 through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. The respondent present pleaded that since the information sought by the appellant is voluminous, the appellant was asked to appear personally on 11.01.2021 to inspect the record and get the relevant information but the appellant did not appear. Further, since some enquiry was pending, the information was not sent to the appellant.

The Commission was not in agreement with the PIO's reply since the PIO had already raised the money for providing the information and the asked amount had been deposited by the appellant.

The PIO was directed to provide the information to the appellant for which the money has been raised (Rs.480 for 240 pages) and send a compliance report to the Commission.

Hearing dated 02.02.2022:

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar/Mohali. As per the appellant, the PIO has not provided the information.

The respondent present pleaded that the enquiry is complete and assured to provide the information to the appellant within 15 days.

Earlier order stands, the PIO is directed to comply with the earlier order of the Commission and provide complete information to the appellant within 15 days of the receipt of the order and send a compliance report to the Commission.

With the above order, the case is **disposed of and closed**. However, it is made clear that if the information is not supplied, the appellant is free to come to Commission again.

- Point-2 Whatever action has been taken on the complaints to be provided
- Point-3 To provide whatever information is available on record
- Point-4 Provide the salary details. Personal property details not to be provided
- Point -5 Not to be provided
- Point-6 To provide
- Point-7,8 &9 Has not asked for any specific information. Not to be created.

The PIO was directed to provide the information as soon as possible and send a compliance report to the Commission.

Hearing dated 02.02.2022:

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. Both the parties are absent.

Earlier order stands. No further interference of the commission is required.

The Case is **disposed of and closed**.
