Not satisfied with the reply of the SPIO, the appellant filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 26.08.2019 and then Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 14.12.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today **through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.**

The appellant is absent today, whereas the respondent is present and he stated that the sought for information has been provided by hand to the appellant on 19.01.2021 and he has executed a duly signed receipt after receiving the information.

The Commission has received an e-mail sent by the SPIO, which is a copy of letter no. AC-4063/2020 dated 28.02.2021 along with a duly signed receipt dated 19.01.2021 of Shri Davinder Sharma, appellant in which he has submitted that he has received the sought for information and also requested to disposed of his appeal case.

As the SPIO has provided the sought for information to the appellant and the appellant has executed a duly signed receipt after receiving the information that he has received the sought for information, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**
