O R D E R

Dr. Kashmir Singh Sohal, complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 08.11.2019 and sought some information from the PIO, O/o Director, Health & Family Welfare, Punjab, Chandigarh. When no information was provided to him by the PIO, then he filed compliant against the PIO before the Punjab State Information Commission on 22.06.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today **through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.**

The complainant-applicant is absent today, whereas the respondents are present. The respondent stated that sought for information was sent to the complainant/applicant vide letter no. 6128 dated 04.12.2019 and then vide letter no. 3890 dated 27.08.2020.

The Commission has received a mail sent by the PIO on 01.09.2020 diarized vide no. 11018, which is copy of letter no. 3894 dated 27.08.2020 along with a copy of letter no. 3890 dated 27.08.20 and a photo copy of the postal receipt dated 27.08.2020. I have gone through the said letter and it is submitted by the PIO that the reply/information was given to the complainant/applicant vide letter no. 6128 dated 04.12.2019 and now again vide letter no. 3890 dated 27.08.2020.

The complainant/applicant filed RTI application on 08.11.2019 and the PIO had sent the reply/information to the complainant/applicant on 04.12.2019, within the stipulated period of 30 days, so no complaint lies against the PIO. Hence, the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed** with the observation that in case the complainant/applicant is not satisfied, then he can file the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority within 20 days from the receipt of this Order.
