Both the parties are present today.

The respondent stated that the information sought by the appellant is related with the Crime Branch.

So the SPIO, O/o DGP, Punjab, Crime Branch is directed that the information/reply, specifically para-wise, be sent to the appellant through registered post within 10 days and copy of the same be sent to the Commission for compliance. In case of non compliance of the order of the Commission, a show cause notice will be issued to the SPIO on the next date of hearing.
