Vinod Kumar, S.D.O.-cum-APIO, who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, states that the information demanded by the appellant through his RTI request is regarding details of appointment of an employee, hence, could not be supplied to him as it is 'third party' information and the appellant was duly informed about this fact through a reply vide letter no. 159-60 dated 04.11.2019. A copy of the reply is placed in the case-file.

After going through the queries raised by the appellant through RTI request, it is found that the information demanded by the appellant at point no 01 to 05 through RTI request is not 'third party' information, hence, directions are hereby given to the respondent PIO to supply the required information demanded by the appellant at point no 01 to 05 of RTI request and information at point no. 06 is not to be given as it is 'personal information'.

An opportunity is given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the information, which would be supplied to him by the respondent PIO. He is also advised to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent PIO concerned.
