The affidavit submitted by the SPIO was accepted, but the amount of compensation of Rs. 2,000/- was not paid to the appellant by the SPIO and he was directed to pay the same to the appellant within a week.

But no compliance report regarding the payment of compensation to the appellant has been sent by the SPIO to the Commission.

So, the SPIO is directed that the amount of compensation of Rs.2,000/- be paid to the appellant from the funds of public authority by way of demand draft and be sent to the appellant through registered post within a week and compliance report be sent to the Commission. In case of non compliance of the order of the Commission a show cause notice will be issued to the SPIO that why you are not obeying the orders of the Commission.

The appellant has filed RTI application on 11.10.2019 and a period of more than one year has been passed, but the SPIO has not provided any information to the appellant. The appellant has suffered a lot. So, a compensation of Rs.2,000/- is awarded in favour of the appellant to be paid by the SPIO from the funds of public authority by way of demand draft and be sent to the appellant through registered post within 10 days.

The SPIO is further directed that the attested copies of sought for information be also sent to the appellant through registered post within 10 days and a copy of the same be sent to the Commission as compliance. In case of non compliance of the Order of the Commission strict action will be taken against the SPIO under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.
