Sh. Gurnam Singh, Assistant Transport Officer-cum-PIO, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that the appellant has visited the office of the respondent to inspect the relevant official record on 12.03.2020 but has not identified any document to supply the same.

The appellant, Sh. Jasbir Singh, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that no inspection of the relevant official record has been done in the instant appeal case.

The respondent PIO concerned is directed to facilitate the appellant to inspect the relevant official record on 16.07.2019 at 11:00 A. M. to identify the required information and the appellant is advised to visit the office of the respondent to inspect the relevant official record on 16.07.2019 at 11:00 A. M to identify the information.

Both the parties mutually agreed to it during the hearing today.

The respondent-PIO concerned is directed to supply the required information, which would be identified by the appellant after inspection, to him by the next date of hearing.

Sh. Gurnam Singh, Assistant Transport Officer-cum-PIO, would remain present during the inspection of the relevant official record.

An opportunity is also given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the information, which would be supplied to him by the respondent PIO after inspection, or not and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned by the next date of hearing.

After hearing the parties concerned, it emerges that the respondent PIO concerned has not complied with the orders dated 20.01.2020 passed by the Commission, through which penalty of Rs. 10,000/- was imposed upon the concerned Public Information Officer of office of Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Faridkot.

Sh. Gurnam Singh, Assistant Transport Officer-cum-PIO, requests for one week's time to comply with the order dated 20.01.2020 passed by the Commission (through which penalty of Rs. 10,000/- was imposed).

Last and final opportunity is given to the respondent PIO concerned to comply with the orders dated 20.01.2020 passed by the Commission by depositing penalty of Rs. 10,000/- which was imposed upon the concerned Public Information Officer of office of Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Faridkot, by the next date of hearing and a copy of challan receipt be sent to the Commission positively.
