

ORDER

- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 24.08.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
- 2. The case has been heard today in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Amarjit Singh Dhamotia, appellant has not come present in person or through cisco webex. He, however, has informed through a telephonic message that he has sent an e.mail stating that he has to attend a case in civil court and thus, is unable to attend the hearing. He, however, states that neither he has been called for inspection of records nor any information has been provided by the PIO.
- 3. Shri Amrinder Singh, PIO, Station House Officer, Police Station, Daba, Ludhiana comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. He produces before the Bench letter dated 01.10.2022 (two copies) explaining the position regarding supply of information as also the position regarding the copies of challans as sought by the appellant. He states that the copies of such challans are submitted to the Traffic Office, Police Lines from which the appellant can seek copies of the same by filing a separate RTI application. He also produces before the Bench copy of a document showing the deduction of penalty amount of Rs.5000/- from his salary.

4. The Bench observes that though the PIO had produced before the Bench copy of

evidence for having deducted Rs.5000/- from his salary, however, evidence for having deposited the

amount of penalty has not been produced before the Bench. The show cause notice, in view of the position

explained by the PIO in his letter dated 01.10.2022, is dropped.

5. The Bench is convinced that adequate information has been given by the PIO. PIO is,

however, directed to send copy of the treasury challan for having deposited the amount of penalty

Rs.5000/- in the Govt. treasury.

6. With the aforesaid directions, the instant matter is disposed off and closed. Copies of

the order be sent to the concerned parties. Copy of the letter dated 01.10.2022 be sent to the appellant

along with the order.

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 24.08.2022 passed by this Bench during the previous hearing.

- 2. The case has been heard today. Shri Rajinder Sofat, appellant comes present in person before the Bench to attend the hearing. He states that he has not been supplied any information.
- 3. Shri Gurwinder Singh, Assistant Estate Officer/PIO, with Shri Ashwani Kumar, Senior Assistant, GMADA, Mohali comes present to attend the hearing. He states that the appellant was called to office on 31.08.2022 and he was allowed inspection of related records and further states that he has brought along a copy of the LOI for handing over to the appellant which contains all the conditions regarding payment of instalments etc. On the asking of the Bench, the PIO hands over copy of the same to the appellant in the court itself.
- 4. The appellant on perusal of same expresses his dis-satisfaction and insists that he be provided a copy of document showing that, interest can be charged on the instalments even without giving possession of plot/ delayed possession.

- 1. The RTI application is dated 07.01.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application.
