ORDER:

- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 03.10.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
- 2. The case has been heard today in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Sarabjeet Singh Gill, appellant has not come present in person or through cisco webex nor any intimation has been received in this regard.
- 3. Dr. Harbans Singh Dhalla, Sr. Veterinary Officer and Dr. Pratishth, Veterinary Officer, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana come present in person before the Bench to attend the hearing. Dr. Pratishth reiterates her statement made during previous hearing that the information has been supplied to the appellant and that an affidavit was also filed on 25.01.2022 by Dr. Yaseen Sheikh, Veterinary Officer
- 4. The perusal of the case file shows that on 21.12.2021, an affidavit and a cheque dated 21.12.2021 were presented before the Bench, which were not accepted, being not in order. The perusal of the case file also shows that the appellant was supplied information which was termed by him to be partial. He was also given opportunities to inspect the records. He, however, never informed the Bench for having inspected the records.

- 5. The Bench observes that the PIO of Zone-C was given directions based on the insertion of appellant in the RTI application, penalty was imposed on PIO O/o Zone C, Municipal Corporation and PIO O/o Medical Officer of Health, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana. However, during deliberations, it transpired that the matter related only to PIO O/o Medical Officer of Health, M.C. Ludhiana. As such, the penalty imposed on the PIO O/o Zone-C, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar is waived off.
- 6. During deliberations in the appeal case, Dr. Pratishth explains before the Bench that the information sought by the appellant relates to different Zones of Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana and it involved creation, collection and compilation of information As regards the penalty imposed on the PIO O/o Medical Officer of Health, M.C. Ludhiana, the respondent states that officers attending the appeal case have been transferred and changed from time to time. This resulted in prolonging the proceedings of the case and delay in supply of information and thus, requested for condoning the penalty imposed on the PIO.
- 7. From perusal of the RTI appellant, the Bench agrees with the contention of the representative of PIO that the information sought involves creation, collection and compilation of the information. The Bench takes into consideration the submissions made by the representative of the PIO/respondent. In view of the submissions of respondents, the Bench withdraws the directions regarding imposition of penalty as also for enhancing it to Rs.10,000/- on the PIO O/o Medical Officer of Health, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana.
- 8. The Bench further observes that the information stands supplied to the appellant. However, since the appellant has expressed dis-satisfaction and stated that information supplied is partial, the Bench directs the PIO O/o Medical Officer of Health, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to file an affidavit on e-stamp paper, within 21 (Twenty one) days, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in official records in AC No.3054/2020 has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and copy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.
- 8. With the aforesaid directions, **the instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.**Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
