Viewing the callous attitude of the PIO seriously, a Show-Cause Notice was issued to Shri Harjinder Singh, PIO-cum-Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-A, Ludhiana to explain reasons as to why a penalty at the rate of Rs. 250/- per day, subject to a maximum of Rs. 25,000/- be not imposed upon him for the delay in the supply of information. An opportunity of personal hearing was afforded to him on the next date of hearing before imposing penalty in the interest of natural justice. He was directed to supply the requisite
