This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 07.11.2019 vide which a compensation of Rs.10,000/- was awarded to the appellant to be paid via Bank Draft drawn through Government Treasury under Section 19(8)(b) of the RTI Act, 2005. The respondent-PIO was directed to supply the information as

the respondent-PIO failed to provide the information.

The appellant states that till date no information has been provided to him. He further states that the appellant applied for supply of information to the PIO/Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana on 7.4.2019, who transferred application to PIO, Tehsildar, Payal on 15.4.2019 and PIO/Tehsildar, Payal further transferred the application to Tehsildar, Khanna on 1.5.2019 under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005. The PIO/Tehsildar, Khanna has written to the appellant to collect the information on 2.9.2019 vide his letter dated 29.8.2019, which was dispatched on 30.8.2019. He further states that today the representative of the respondent-PIO shows a letter to be dispatched on 30.11.2019, when the next date of hearing is 3.12.2019.

sought by the appellant under the provisions of RTI Act, 2005. It was also mentioned that regarding imposition of penalty decision will be taken on the next date of hearing, if

3. The representative of the respondents states that Shri Harminder Singh Hundal, Tehsildar-cum-PIO, Khanna stated to him that he has presented a letter on 25.11.2019 to Hon'ble CIC, the contents of which are as under:-

"With reference to the above said appeal case, this is to submit respectfully that no such information record exists in my pertaining the information sought by the applicant and reply pertaining to above said information was sent to the applicant vide letter No.177 RTI dated 30.07.2019. A compensation to the tune of Rs.10,000/- was imposed by this Hon'ble Court to the undersigned for not providing the information in time. Sir, a sincere effort was made to provide information to the applicant by communicating with different offices. Even now, every effort will be made to help the applicant so that the requisite information may be provided. Sir, since this is a first instance regarding imposition of compensation, a considerate view may please be taken and compensation may be waived off. I will ensure due diligence in future, Sir."

The respondent PIO sent a letter dated 30.11.2019 to the appellant, which has not received by the appellant, (a copy of the same has been received in the Commission through e-mail) the necessary contents of which are as under:-

- 3. After hearing both the parties and going through the record available on the case file, it is revealed that application for seeking information is dated 7.4.2019 and reply is given only on 30.11.2019 after the lapse of about 9 months stating that information cannot be provided after creating. He is directed to supply the information to the appellant after transferring the application to another department under Section 6(3) and take assistance of another official under 5(4) of the RTI Act, 2005, because no reply has been given within stipulated period under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005. Last opportunity is given to Shri Harminder Singh, the respondent-PIO, to supply the information to the appellant and comply the previous order for award of compensation to the appellant via demand draft through Government Treasury, failing which the matter will be decided for imposition of penalty on the next date of hearing. The application given on 25.11.2019 by Tehsildar-cum-PIO is rejected.

- 3. In compliance to the previous order, the respondent-PIO has failed to provide the sought for action taken report to the complainant. Thus the Commission draws the inference that the PIO, without any reasonable cause, has refused to furnish

the information to the complainant and has malafidily denied him the same and thus, has rendered himself liable for punishment as provided under the RTI Act, 2005. Viewing the absence of the respondent seriously, the PIO is, thus, issued a show cause notice to explain in a self-attested affidavit as to why a penalty @ Rs.250/- per day of delay subject to a maximum of Rs.25000/- till the complete information is furnished, be not imposed under Section 20(1) of RTI Act, 2005 on him for causing willful delay/denial of the information to the RTI applicant.

- 4. In addition to the written reply, the PIO is also given an opportunity under Section 20(1) proviso thereto, for a personal hearing before imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. He may take note that in case he does not file his written reply and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex parte.
- 5. Last opportunity is given the respondent-PIO to supply the information within 10 days to the complainant. On receipt of the information from the respondent-PIO, the complainant is advised to go through the same and revert back to the authorities, in case of deficiencies in the information with a copy to the Commission. The respondent-PIO is directed to remove the deficiencies on its receipt from the complainant before the next date of hearing.
- 4. To come up on 12.12.2019 at 3.30 P.M. to be heard through Video Conference Facility available in the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhaina.
