

The complainant/applicant sought information regarding Baba Zorawar Singh Co-op. House Building Society, Housefed Complex, Banur. Through point no. 'a' of the RTI application he sought information regarding copy of By-Laws of the Society, which has already been provided to him by the SPIO.

Through point 'b' of the RTI application the complainant/applicant sought copy of all proceedings of General Body meeting of the Society, which cannot be provided to him as the societies are not declared as public authorities U/s 2(h) of the RTI Act, 2005.

Through point no. 'c' of the RTI application the complainant/applicant sought copy of all the instructions issued by the Registrar, co-op. Societies, Punjab and through point no. 'd' he sought copy of rights and privileges of the members, which are covered in the By-Laws of the Society as submitted by the respondent.
