2. Respondent, Ms. Shobha Rani states that requisite information has already been sent to the appellant.

5. I am of the view that due to evasive attitude of the respondent PIO concerned, the appellant has suffered a lot of detriments for not getting the requisite information, I am of the view that compensation be awarded to the appellant, Sh. Daizy Mohan.
6. Hence, I award an interim compensation of Rs. 1,500/- (Fifteen Hundred Only) to the appellant. The compensation amount must be paid by the respondent PIO concerned through cheque or demand draft in favor of **Daizy Mohan** from the account of Public Authority and not from the individual's account.
7. Respondent PIO is directed to produce a copy of the cheque or demand draft on the next date of hearing.
