larger public interest seeking such information of particular official. The attention of the appellant is invited to the Supereme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.6454, Central Board of Secondary Education Vs Aditya Bandopadhayay and ors. has in its judgement dated 09.08.2021 observed as under:-

"37 Indiscriminate and impractical demands or directions under RTI Act for disclosure of all and sundary information (unrelated to transparency and accountability in the functioning of public authorites and eradication of corruption) would be conter-productive as it will adversely affect the efficacy of the administration and result in the executive getting bogged down with the non-productive work of collection and furnishing information. The Act should not be allowed to be misused or abused, to become a tool to obstruct the national development and integration, or to destroy the peace, tranquility and harmony among its citizens. Nor should it be converted into a tool of oppression or intimidation of honest officials striving to do their duty. The nation does not want a scenario where 75% of the staff of public authorities spends 75% of their time in collecting and furnishing information to appellants instead of discharing their regular duties. The threat of penalties under the RTI Act and the pressure of the authorities under the RTI Act should not lead to employees of a public authorities prioritizing 'information furnishing' at the cost of their normal and regular duties".
