**ORDER:**

The appellant through an RTI application dated 21.12.2020 has sought information regarding the number of ambulances in the name of Red Cross Society, work of ambulance – number of patients leave to hospital- logbook of ambulances & bills from the year 2015 till date as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of President, Red Cross Society, Kapurthala. The appellant was not provided with the information provided after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the first appellate authority on 04.03.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Kapurthala. The respondent present pleaded that the appellant was asked to vide letter dated 19.04.2021 to inspect the record and get the relevant information to which he agreed. However, the appellant did not turn up and filed the first appeal on 04.03.2021 with the First Appellate Authority which ordered to send the information to the appellant through registered post. The information (635 pages) was sent to the appellant vide letter dated 02.06.2021. Thereafter, the appellant again requested for inspection of the record which was allowed. The appellant after inspecting the record on 17.08.2021, asked for some more documents which have also been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 09.09.2021.

The Commission has also received a reply from the PIO on 24.09.2021 which has been taken on the file of the Commission.

The appellant is absent nor has communicated any discrepancies. It is presumed that the appellant has received the information and is satisfied.

Since the information has been provided, no further course of action is required. The case is **disposed of and closed**.

The appellant through an RTI application dated 06.01.2021 has sought information regarding action taken on the application relating to misuse of Atta Dal Scheme during the distribution of wheat in August-Sept/ and other information as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of Secretary Civil Food Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Pb Chandigarh. The appellant was not provided with the information provided after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the first appellate authority on 26.02.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Faridkot/Mohali. The respondent was present from the office of Food Civil Suppliers Nakhana, Distt.Bathinda informed that they received the RTI application on 29.04.2021 through their head office and since the enquiry was pending, the reply was sent to the appellant vide letter dated 20.05.2021. Thereafter, on completion of enquiry proceedings, complete information has been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 03.06.2021 and the appellant has acknowledged having received the information.

The appellant is absent nor is represented.

Since the appellant has received the information, no further interference is required in the matter. Case **disposed of and closed**.
