ORDER

Shri Mohammad Khalil, appellant filed RTI application dated 20.08.2020 and sought some information from the PIO, O/o BDPO, Malerkotla-1, Distt. Sangrur.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.

Both the parties are present today. The appellant stated that complete sought for information has not been provided to him by the PIO.

The respondent stated that the information/reply has been sent to the appellant vide letter no.192 dated 16.03.2021 and letter no.196 dated 18.03.2021. He further stated that all the information has been sent to the appellant except information regarding para no.1 of the RTI application. He stated that regarding para no.1 of the RTI application, letter number 2328 dated 03.12.2020 and again letter dated 05.04.2021 was written to the Naib Tehsildar, Amargarh to submit report regarding land demarcation of khasra numbers in village Dalergarh as mentioned in the RTI application, but the Naib Tehsildar has not submitted the report till date.

The PIO has provided the information to the appellant, which was available in his office, whereas the information regarding para no.1 of the RTI application, the PIO has written letter number 2328 dated 03.12.2020 and again letter dated 05.04.2021 to the Naib Tehsildar, Amargarh to submit report regarding land demarcation of khasra numbers in village Dalergarh, but he has not submitted the report as yet.

So, the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed** with the observation that whenever the Naib Tehsildar, Amargarh will submit the report of land demarcation of khasra numbers in Village Dalergarh, then the attested copies of information be sent to the appellant through registered post within 10 days and compliance report be sent to the Commission.
