4. The appellant is contacted on mobile phone. He is apprised of the version of the PIO regarding deposit of Rs.952/-. He states that the fee for the supply of information sought by him has not

been asked for within the prescribed period and as such, he has not deposited any amount with the PIO.

5. Post deliberations, the Bench observes that delay is there in demanding the fee for the information and agrees with the contention of the appellant. The Bench also scrutinises the information as produced before the Bench by the APIO and finds it in order. Accordingly, the Bench directs the PIO that the appellant be supplied information free of cost by registered post duly attested by the PIO within

next seven days.

6. The APIO assures to do the needful.
