8. Respondent PIO is directed to produce a copy of the cheque or demand draft on the next date of hearing.

9. Respondent PIO is directed to supply the requisite information to the complainant by the next date of hearing. He is also directed to appear in person before the Commission to represent this case, failing to which action as per RTI Act will be initiated against him.

10. It is also observed that complainant is very senior citizen so this case is fixed for further hearing through Video Conference dated 19.02.2020 at 11:00 AM through NIC Facility at the Deputy Commissioner Office, Amritsar.
