- 1. The RTI application is dated 17.11.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 22.01.2021 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 22.06.2021 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 05.10.2021 through V.C. in DC Office, Amritsar. Accordingly, the case has been heard today. Shri Jasbir Singh, appellant attends the hearingthrough V.C.
- 3. Shri Sudhir Kumar, SDO O/o Dy.Chief Engineer, Operation, Urban Circle, PSPCL, comes present to attend the hearing on behalf of the PIO. He states that the appellant has been supplied point wise information vide letter dated 15.03.2021. He states that the information has been sought by the

appellant regarding installation of pillar boxes for electricity meters which were installed six years back and at that time, no objection was raised by anybody to the installation of these boxes. He further states that the information was also given to the appellant by hand on 01.10.2021.

- 4. On the asking of the Bench, the appellant Shri Jasbir Singh states that he is not satisfied with the information which is misleading as it does not solve his problem regarding shifting of pillar box installed before his house which is creating problem in entry to his house. He also contends that his consent was not sought at the time of installing pillar box and this pillar box incidentally does not contain his meter.
- 5. The representative of the PIO states that in shifting of pillar box, an estimate is prepared and the appellant has been asked to deposit the amount of estimate to enable them to shift the pillar box.
- 6. Post deliberations, the Bench observes that so far as the shifting of pillar box is concerned, it is an executive action. However, the Bench directs the PIO to again call the appellant to his office and allow him access to the relevant records. The appellant, after inspection of records, will identify the information and the information so identified as also the copy of relevant electricity rules as asked for vide RTI application, will be supplied to him before the next hearing.
- Thereafter, the PIO is directed to file an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public, to the effect that the information as available in the official records in AC No.2875/2021 has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and photocopy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.
- 8. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. To come up for hearing on 11.01.2022 at 11.30 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
