- 4. Last opportunity is given to the PIO to appear and state the case, failing which action under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 will be initiated.
- 5. The matter to come up for further hearing now on 31.01.2018 at 12.30PM through video conference at o/o Deputy Commissioner, Faridkot. Both the parties should appear on the above said venue. Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
