An email has been received in the Commission form email id gsssgobindpurabti@gmail.com of respondent mentioning therein that appellant has nowhere mentioned that whose ACR report he is asking for in his RTI application and also it is not mentioned that he is requesting for his own ACR report. It is further that ACR is confidential departmental record and no public interest is shown by the appellant and requested the Commission to dispose of this case.
4. Sh. Padaraj Singh, clerk stated as mentioned above in point no. 3 of this order.
5. After hearing the respondent and examining the documents placed on record, it is found that vague information is requisite in RTI application and in the view of above, no further action is required in this case at this instant and hence this instant appeal case is **disposed of and closed**
