ORDER

- 1. The RTI application is dated 13.01.2022 vide which the Complainant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. Complaint was filed in the Commission on 24.02.2022 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 06.06.2022. The case has been heard today. Shri Jatinder Singh, complainant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. He states that no information has been received by him.
- 3. Neither the PIO has come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench or through cisco webex nor he has deputed any of his representatives to attend the hearing.
- 4. The Bench observes that the complainant denies the receipt of any information and has directly approached the Commission by preferring complaint in the Commission. The Bench further observes that the complainant has not availed the provision of Section 19(1) of the RTI Act by filing an appeal with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). As such, the FAA has not been able to address the grievances of the complainant. The attention of the Complainant is drawn to the decision of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered on 12.12.2011

in Information Commissioner and another Versus State of Manipur and another in para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information which is as under:-

31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the Hon'ble High Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information."

As such, since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

- 5. Since there is an alternative and efficacious remedy of First Appeal available to the Complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 which has not been availed in the instant complaint case and the First Appellate Authority has not had the occasion to review the decision of PIO, as envisaged under the RTI Act by passing a detailed well reasoned speaking order.
- 6. The instant matter is remanded back to the **First Appellate Authority i.e. Shri**, **Parvinder Singh Khamba**, **Chief Engineer**, **Central Zone**, **PSPCL**, **Ludhiana**. The Commission hereby directs the FAA to treat the copy of the Complaint (enclosed herewith) as the First Appeal and decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act after giving all concerned parties an opportunity to be heard. He is directed to hear the complainant within ten days and decide the matter.
- 7. In case, the complainant is not satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority (FAA), he is at liberty to file second appeal before Punjab State Information Commission Section 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.
- 8. In view of the above, **the case is disposed off and closed.** Copy of the order be sent to the parties.

ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated 15.11.2021 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 01.01.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 24.02.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 06.06.2022. Accordingly, the case has been heard today. Ms. Manu Kataria, appellant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. She states that she has received reply dated 20.04.2022 from the PIO that the enquiry referred to in RTI application of the appellant is still under process and unless it is not finalized, the information cannot be supplied to the appellant.

3. Shri Jaswinder Singh, Addl. S.E., O&M Division, PSPCL, Khanna, District Ludhiana comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench and refers to the letter of PIO dated 20.04.2022 sent to the Commission wherein it has been stated that as the enquiry in the matter is still under process, the information cannot be supplied to the appellant unless it is finalised, under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005.

- On the asking of the Bench, the appellant contends the version of the PIO and produces a copy of letter dated 15.02.2022 before the Bench. She states that as per this letter of Addl. S.E. P&M Division, Khanna written to the Addl. S.E. Distribution Division, PSPCL, Sirhind, the Inquiry Officer has submitted enquiry report to the Deputy Chief Engineer, P&M Circle, Ludhiana and further states that on the basis of said enquiry report, she has also been transferred to PSPCL, Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.
- 5. Post deliberations with the appellant and the representative of PIO, the Bench directs the PIO-cum-Dy.Chief Engineer/P&M Circle, PSPCL, Ludhiana to file an affidavit on nonjudicial stamp paper, within 21 (twenty one) days, to the effect that the departmental enquiry initiated as per letter dated 28.09.2021 & 30.09.2021 is still under process and copy of the enquiry report cannot be provided to the appellant under Section 8(1)(j) of RTI Application. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and copy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.
- 6. With the aforesaid directions, the appeal case is disposed off and closed. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
