3. The respondent-Public Information Officer submitted the point wise reply specifically regarding the remaining information. After ascertaining the same it has transpired that the respondent authority has suitably been replied to the appellant except the following pertaining to Point No. 4 of the RTI application:-

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 28.7.2021.
