#### ORDER

Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.  
The RTI request is dated 25.09.2018. First appeal is dated 03.08.2019. Second  
appeal has been received in the Commission on 20.04.2020.  
On the last date of hearing, held on 28.07.2021;

- i) Neither the appellant nor the respondent was present.
- ii) The respondent PIO through a reply vide letter no. 76 dated 03.04.2021 had intimated the Commission that the requisite information was supplied to the appellant vide letter no. 56 dated 18.03.2021.
- iii) An opportunity was given to the appellant to confirm whether he received the information and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned.

After examining the documents placed on record, it is found that the respondent PIO through a reply vide letter no. 76 dated 03.04.2021 signed by Public Information Officer-cum-Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Patti Distt. – Tarn Taran, which was received in the Commission vide Diary No. 12781 dated 11.06.2021, had intimated the Commission that the requisite information was supplied to the appellant vide letter no. 56 dated 18.03.2021 and the appellant has not pointed out any deficiency in the information supplied to him till date. The RTI request is dated 23.12.2020. First appeal is dated 27.01.2020. Second  
appeal has been received in the Commission on 18.05.2020.

On the last date of hearing, held on 28.07.2021,

- i) Ms. Jaswant Kaur, Deputy Registrar, stated that the appellant visited the office on 03.02.2021 and the requisite information was supplied to the appellant.
- ii) The appellant stated that incomplete information was given to him as whether pay scale/grade pay for the post of Business Manager revised in 2011 and if revised, mention the post with which pay anomaly has occurred while giving benefit to appellant and also mention pay scale before revision as well as after revision.
