- 1. The RTI application is dated 15.12.2020 vide which the Complainant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. Complaint was filed in the Commission on 03.03.2021 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The complainant Shri Heera Lal comes present in person before the Bench to attend the hearing. He states that he has sought information/documents regarding new electricity connection released in the name of Pawan Kumar in his house whereas an electricity connection has been running in the name of complainant and the same has been disconnected, which is wrong and illegal.
